
The ignoring of the contribution from the housewives inside the family

### Inspiration and ideas



I' m not sure how to make the plot seem reasonable and natural. At first I thought the neglect within the family members to the housewife's labour was a good feature for the plot, and I don't think the storyboard is clear because at the end the two are drowned in rubbish doesn't prove anything and would create a unclear narrative.

At the end, I use the fish image to represent the father and the son. Because fish cannot survive without water, I think housewife's labour is a source of water. Like the air to people, they take it for granted every day, but they cannot live without it. So at the end of the animation, the water is reduced, and the fish father and son feel the pain of not able to breathe because of the lack of water.



When I collect some information, I learned that I can use cute characters or some animals to develop the story to avoid making the character design too sharp. At first, I used the image of a cat in the story, but later changed it to a fish because it was not appropriate enough. At the end I found that the image was not dynamic enough as I cannot use the pen tool well enough to do the movement, I drew it in ps first and then edit it in ae, which is certainly very limiting. I will practice some of the techniques in ae and use them in my next animation.
